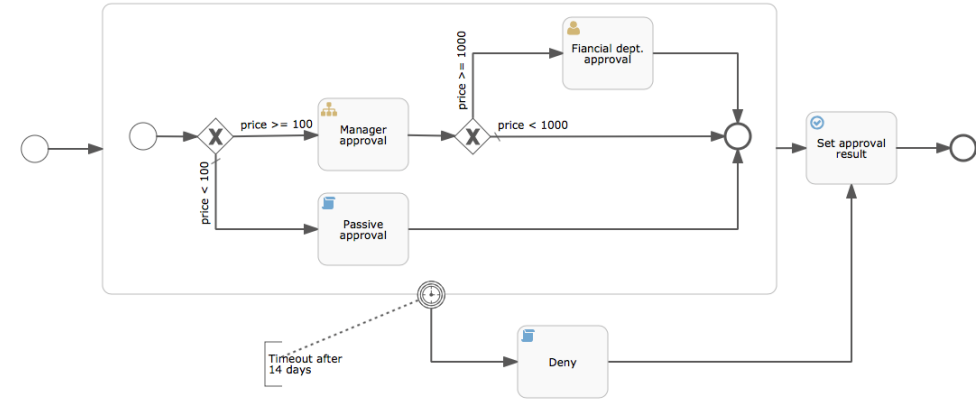

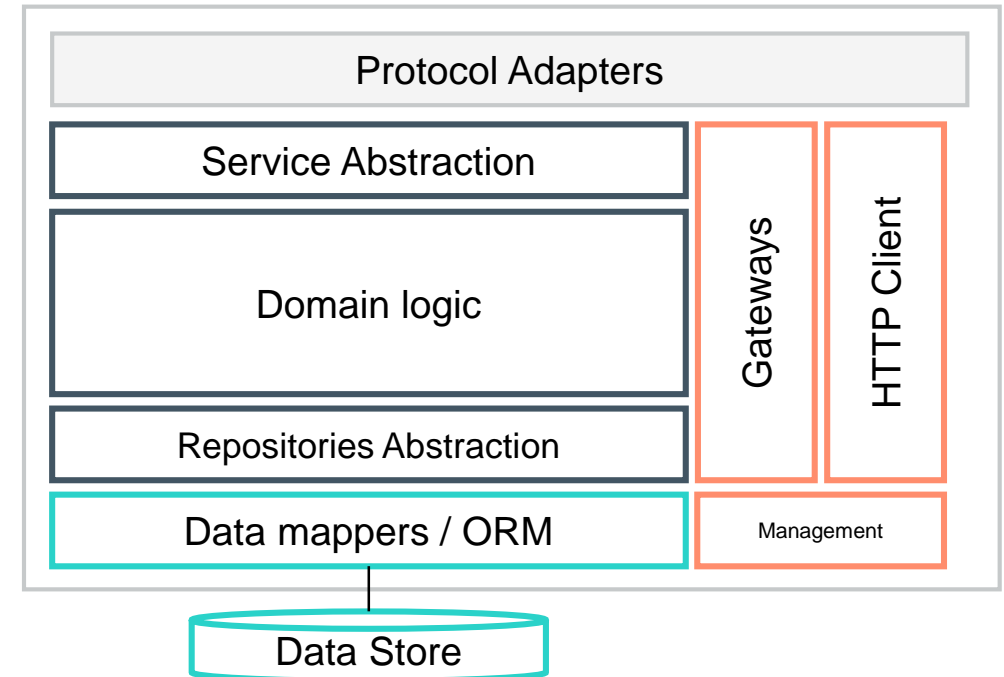
## Architecture Pattern:



- In principle, it is the manifestation of the **single responsibility principles**.
- The services are as **small as possible**, but as **large as needed** for their area of responsibility.
- Micro services **work together to provide business value**.

## Functional Architecture:

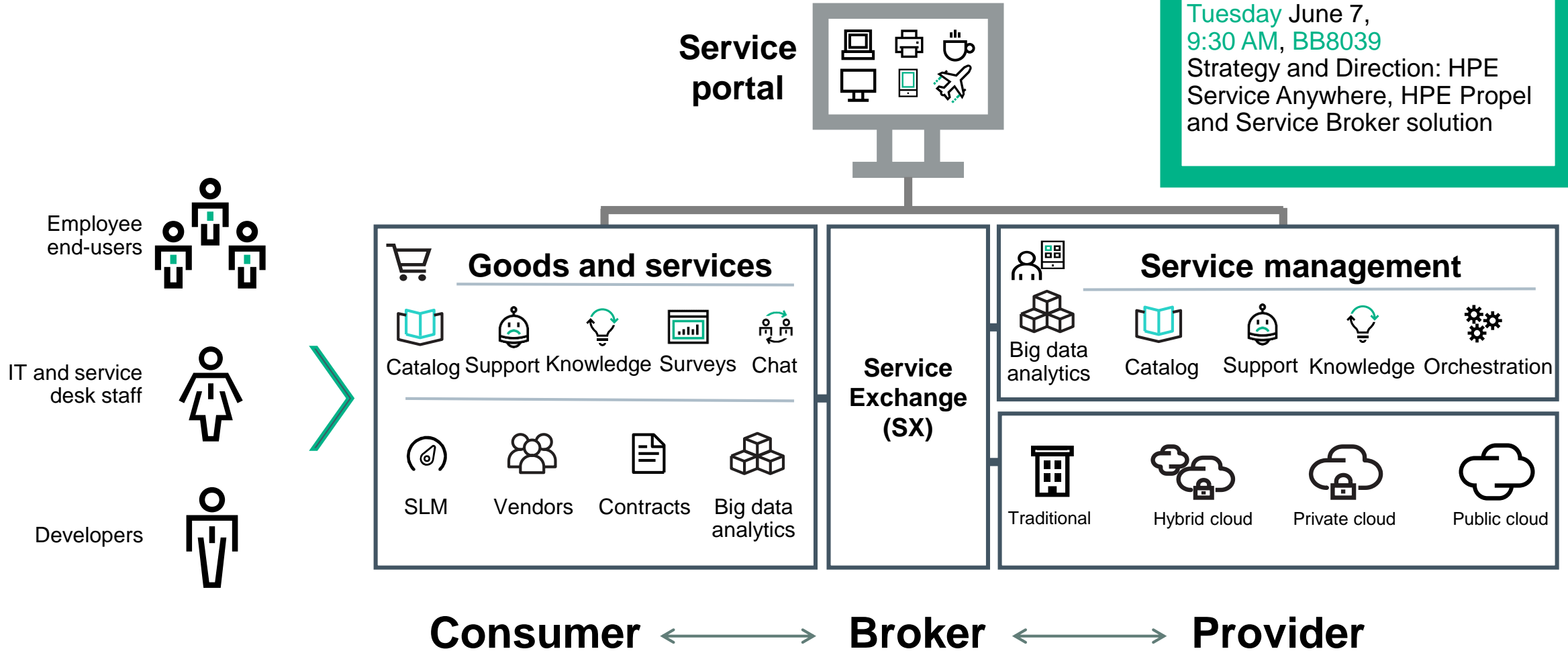
- Often integrated using **REST over HTTP** and can often be split into similar kinds of modules.
